EMERGENCY CLOSURE NOTICE 2020

Monmouthshire County Council in exercise of its powers under The Health Protection (Coronavirus Restrictions) (Wales) Regulations 2020 and of all other enabling powers, hereby closes, to all users, restricted byways 20 and 21 Monmouth as described in the schedule below, for an undefined period as long as the above regulation is in force, or the Authority considers the high risk to the incidence or spread of infection with coronavirus has rescinded. This closure will be kept under review. Failure to comply can result in a summary conviction and fine as indicated in the legislation and guidance.

SCHEDULE

Location The paths to be closed, as shown on the attached plan, are Restricted Byway 21 running from its junction with Footpath 24 over cattle grid and running up drive and through Buckholt Farm where it then continues as Restricted Byway 20 in a southerly direction to its junction with Footpath 23 north of Newton Court Farm.

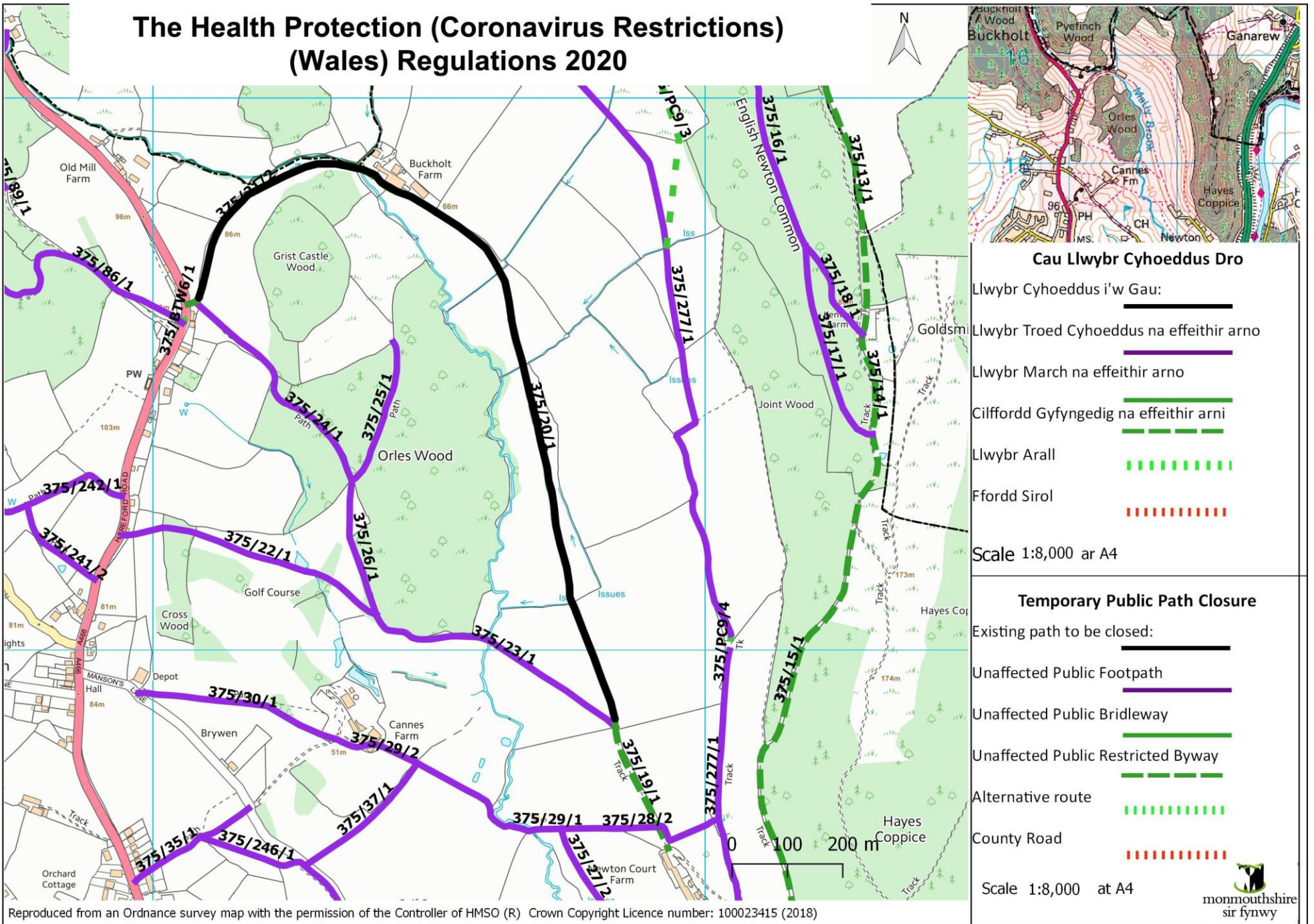
