

6wnelech eich Celfwaith Crog wal eich hun

Weave Your Own Wall Hanging



Beth i'w wneud:

1. Cymerwch eich tair ffon a'u gosod mewn siâp triongl, gan orgyffwrdd pob pen gan tua 5cm.
2. Clymwch y ffyn gyda'i gilydd yn y siâp triongl gan ddefnyddio tri darn byr o liny. Lapiwch y llinyn yn dynn o amgylch y pennau sy'n gorgyffwrdd, a'i glymu mewn cwlwm dwbl. Torrwch i ffwrdd unrhyw ben llac.
3. Cymerwch hyd hir arall o liny a'i ddefnyddio i wau gwe o amgylch y tu mewn i'r triongl canghennau - edrychwch ar yr esiampl i'ch helpu.
4. Nawr rydych yn barod i addurno eich celfwaith crog wal. Tyciwch ddail drwy'r we liny yng nghanol y triongl. Cymerwch eich addurniadau sy'n weddill a'u clymu i ddarnau byr o liny. Yna clymwch y llinynnau i'r gangen gwaelod.
5. Clymwch ddarn o liny i ben y triongl ac mae eich celfwaith crog wal yn barod i'w hongian!

What to do:

1. Take your three sticks and lay them out in a triangle shape, overlapping the ends by around 5cm.
2. Tie the twigs together into a triangle using three short pieces of string. Wrap the string tightly around the overlapping ends and tie in a double knot. Cut off any loose ends.
3. Take another long length of string and use it to weave a web around the inside of the twig triangle - look at the example to help you.
4. Now you are ready to decorate your wall hanging. Tuck leaves through the string web in the middle of the triangle. Take your remaining decorations and tie them to short pieces of string. Then tie the strings on to the bottom twig.
5. Tie a piece of string to the top of the triangle and your wall hanging is ready to hang up!



Byddwch angen:

3 changen gadarn o hyd tebyg (mae tua 20cm-30cm o hyd yn gweithio'n dda)

Ychydig o fetrau o gortyn naturiol, llinyn cotwm neu wllân lliwgar

Ychydig o addurniadau naturiol fel plu glân, dail neu foch coed

You will need:

3 sturdy twigs of similar length (around 20cm-30cm in length works well)

A few metres of natural twine, cotton string or coloured wool

Some found natural decorations such as clean feathers, leaves or pinecones
