£2,912,000

Worth of funding was secured to deliver Biodiversity, Green Infrastructure and Active Travel projects for 2021.



£580,000

in grant funded projects were delivered for Green Infrastructure, Biodiversity and Active Travel improvements and opportunities.



538

planning applications for Biodiversity were completed alongside the development of policy advice for Green Infrastructure.



24

additional nature conservations were designated, contributing to a total of more than 700 sites for targeted conservation action.



We supported our protected landscapes, Wye Alley AONB and Blaenavon Industrial World Heritage Site through partnerships, projects and community grants schemes.



Supported and helped deliver GI town centre enhancements at Caldicot and inputted and progressed active travel projects across Monmouthshire.



Provided guidance on management of our grasslands, verges and public open spaces for pollinators working with our grounds maintenance team on projects to deliver management of our grasslands, school grounds and an emerging Mitchel Troy Triangle trial plot project.
