Tree Planting

Two trees to be planted on corner plots as follows:

Common Name	Scientific Name	Native to the UK?	Size	No. of Plants
Field maple	Acer campestre	Yes	3-3.5m	2

Use standards (10-12cm girth and 3-3.5m tall) planted in square pit minimum 600mm wide and 120mm deeper than rootball. Roughen pit sides and fill pit with sandy loam. Root collar to surrounding soil level. Stake and tie to one third of tree height. Mulch of shredded bark in 1m diameter. Watered within 10 days of planting.

Orchard Planting

Twelve orchard trees to be planted on corner plots as follows:

Common Name	Scientific Name	Native to the UK?	Size	No. of Plants
Apple	Malus domestica	No	15L Pot	10
Pear	Pyrus communis 'Concorde'	No	7.5L Pot	1
Walnut	Juglans regia	No	9L Pot	1

Planted and staked with mulch of shredded bark in 1m diameter.

Wildflower Areas (On corners and in Orchard)

Grass mowing to be relaxed to single annual cut with cutting removed, apart from margins to be cut regularly to maintain tidy appearance. When cutting grass be careful to avoid damaging tree bark (leave set back). Total of No 100 wildflower plugs to be planted in random locations around the two corner trees (10%) each and within the orchard (80% of the total) in autumn/spring. 
