Tree Planting

Four trees to be planted as follows:

Common Name	Scientific Name	Native to the UK?	Size	No. of Plants
Field maple	<i>Acer campestre</i>	Yes	3-3.5m	1
Hornbeam	<i>Carpinus betulus</i>	Yes	3-3.5m	1
Silver birch	<i>Betula pendula</i>	Yes	3-3.5m	1
Common lime	<i>Tilia x europaea</i>	Yes	3-3.5m	1

Use standards (>10-12cm girth and 3-3.5m tall) planted in square pit minimum 600mm wide and 120mm deeper than rootball. Roughen pit sides and fill pit with sandy loam. Root collar to surrounding soil level. Stake and tie to one third of tree height. Watered within 10 days of planting.

Bird Box

Bird nesting box to be mounted near top of east-facing wall of toilet block (approximately) 3m above ground facing east. Use Schwegler <https://www.nhbs.com/1b-schwegler-nest-box> woodcrete box with 26mm diameter hole. (or similar alternative approved by the Council).

Bat Box

Bat roosting box (Schwegler 1FF https://www.schwegler-natur.de/portfolio_1395072079/fledermausflachkasten-1ff/?lang=en or alternative approved by Council) to be mounted near top of south-facing wall of toilet block (approximately) 3m above ground.

SuDS Planters

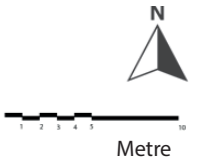
SuDS Planters: Use 2000x600mm sized planters - see <https://www.sudsplanter.com/product-range> or a suitable alternative agreed by the Council.

Each planter to be planted with the following and surface mulched with slate:

Common Name	Scientific Name	Native to the UK?	Size	No. of Plants
Harts tongue fern	<i>Asplenium scolopendrium</i>	No	1.5L Pot	3
Bugle	<i>Adjugas reptans</i>	Yes	1L Pot	3
Bellflower	<i>Campanula glomerata</i>	Yes	1L Pot	3
Lesser periwinkle	<i>Vinca minor</i>	No	1L Pot	3
